Notes:

This is one of my favorite senior backgrounds, yet cost less than \$30 to build. Start by using a product called "Liquid Nails" to glue soda cans to a 5/8ths sheet of plywood. It'll take a bunch. Then paint the can bottoms flat black. Use a colored gel on your background light to turn the cans any color you wish. Great for matching up to subjects clothing or school colors.
