Notes:

One of the best features of the Metz 45CL-4 is that it has two flash heads. The main head sits atop the flash, puts out a majority of the flash's power and pivots toward the ceiling for bouncing. The second flash or "wink" flash fills in shadows under eyebrows, noses and chins.

In this shot, the main head is pointed at the ceiling in a 45 degree angle. The wink flash is filling small shadows.
